Who's footprints are you following?

What's your hypothesis? For the biggest surprise, an adult should make a path of footprints for the young explorer to follow. At the end of the path, place the matching character card with the green leafy side, facing up. The path can continue around the home with the next ten footprints, followed by the matching character card (green leafy side facing up). Repeat again with the last ten footprints and matching character card.

Each footprint also features one of thirty different dinosaurs along with its own dinosaur trivia! For additional challenge, the explorer can turn over each footprint and name the dinosaur before continuing to the next footprint.

Dino Activity Challenge

Challenge no. 1:

Can you walk in the actual steps of a full grown T. rex? Here's what you do to find out! Place all ten of **Buddy's footprints on the floor in a line as shown. Now, take a footprint from the middle of the line and place it at the front of the line.**

Finally, remove all the footprints between the first and the last.

This is the approximate distance of one T. rex step. Can to step from one to the other?

Can you jump from one to the other?

A T.trex "step" is approximately 11 of Buddy's foot prints, end to end!



Dino Activity Challenge

Challenge no. 2:

Can you walk in the actual steps of a full grown Triceratops? Place all ten of **Tank's footprints on the floor in a line as shown. Remove extra footprints. This is the approximate distance of one Triceratops step.**

Can to step from one to the other?
Can you jump from one to the other?

A Triceratops "step" is approximately 10 of Tank's foot prints, end to end!
