
# MATE DINOPEDIA

# **Battery replacement**

Tool required - Small Phillips head screwdriver.

- Using a Phillips head screwdriver, loosen the screw in the battery cover and remove the battery cover.
- Insert 2 AG13/LR44 batteries as indicated in the battery compartment
- Replace battery cover and tighten screw. 3.

## BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION

- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged
- under adult supervision.
  Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed.
  Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- - Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries. Do not dispose of batteries in fire. Battery may explode or leak.
