The Great Outdoors



Requires a small Phillips-head screwdriver.

 Using a Phillips-head screwdriver, loosen the screw in the battery cover, and remove the battery cover as shown.

 Insert four AA/LR6 batteries (not included) as indicated in the battery compartment.

Replace battery cover and retighten screw.
